



YEAR 9 Scholarships 2019

Information for Applicants

Regulations

- The scholarships were established in 2002 by the Board of Trustees of Cashmere High School.
- Scholarships are awarded annually: four Leadership, two Academic, one each for Māori, Music, and Sport.
- A candidate shall be awarded only one scholarship.
- The value of the Academic, Māori, Music and Sport scholarships is \$1,000. These funds will be credited to the student's school account (not transferable) at the start of the school year and can be used to cover school expenses (including the purchase of uniform items).
- The value of the Leadership Scholarships is \$250 by way of a uniform voucher redeemable through the Cashmere High School Uniform Shop.
- The scholarships are open to any Year 8 student who is a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident, who is applying for entry to Year 9 at Cashmere High School in 2019. Scholarships can only be awarded to in-zone students or students who win a place in any ballot the school may have.
- Successful applicants will be offered a scholarship on **17th August 2018**, although academic scholarships will be offered by **19th October 2018** (once external assessment has been completed).
- The acceptance of a place and scholarship must be confirmed by **24th August 2018** and **31st October 2018** for academic.
- Once a decision has been reached no correspondence shall be entered into.
- The Board of Trustees reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship should the successful applicant, in the view of the Principal, not meet the required standards of attendance and work performance.

Selection Criteria and Application Procedure

Leadership Scholarship

- Selection is by interview with the Head of School for Year 9, 2019 and a Deputy Principal.
- Applicants must have shown excellent leadership in their current school as a Year 8 student
- Complete and return the Scholarship Application form to the school before **4.00pm on 27th July 2018**.
- Submit a summary of leadership roles in which the applicant has been involved as a Year 8 student. **This summary must be endorsed by the Principal or a Senior Teacher of the applicant's current school.** (Please note a full Curriculum Vitae is **not** required).
- Applicants will be shortlisted and those required for an interview on the afternoon of **Wednesday 15th August 2018** will be notified.

Academic Scholarship

- No application required as this is awarded as part of the Year 8 entrance testing process.

Māori Scholarship

- Selection is by interview with the Māori teachers and a Deputy Principal. Applicants must have interest and involvement in Taha Māori.
- Complete the application form. There is a section in which to list iwi affiliation/s. Confirmation of Māori descent must be certified by an iwi representative e.g. kaumatua, kuia, Māori teacher or leader of a Māori community group.
- Submit a curriculum vitae statement introducing yourself. This should include academic, cultural and sporting achievements and any hapū, iwi and community involvement.
- Applicants will be shortlisted and those required for an interview on **Wednesday 15th August 2018** will be notified.

Māori Tohu

- Mā te uiuitanga i ngā kaiako Māori me tētahi Tūmuaki Awhina ka whiriwhiri. Me ū te kaitono ki tōna Taha Māori.
- Whakautua te pepa tonu. Whakakī tēnei wahanga ki o hapū me o iwi hoki. Mā tētahi kaumātua, tētahi kuia, tētahi kaiako Māori, tētahi kaihautū hāpori Māori rānei koe e tautoko ki tō tonu.
- Hōmai he kōrero tuhi e whakahua ana koe. Kei roto hoki i tēnei kōrero tuhi he kōrero mōu i te kura he kōrero mōu i ngā tikanga Māori, he kōrero mōu i ngā hākinakina me ngā kōrero ki tōu ake hapū, ki tōu ake iwi, ki tōu ake hāpori hoki.
- Ka whakarāpopoto ngā kaitono. Kātahi ka uiui atu ki ngā kaitono kua eke ā te ata o te Rāapa te 15 o Akuhata.

Music Scholarship

- Selection is by audition with the Head of Arts Faculty and the Head of the Music Department. Applicants must have an interest and ability in some aspect of music. There should be evidence of passion and commitment to excel in some aspect of music.
- Complete and return the application form.
- Submit a musical curriculum vitae statement, including the name of at least one registered music teacher able to testify to the applicant's musical ability and current musical involvement.
- Applicants will be shortlisted and those required for an audition on the afternoon of **Wednesday 15th August 2018** will be notified.

Sport Scholarship

- Selection is by interview with the Sports Coordinator and Deputy Principal with responsibility for Sport. Applicants must have displayed outstanding skill and talent in one or more sporting codes. There should be evidence of passion and commitment to excel in some aspect of sport.
- Complete and return the application form.
- Submit a sporting curriculum vitae statement including the names of at least one coach able to testify to the applicant's sporting ability and current sporting involvement.
- Applicants will be shortlisted and those required for an interview on the afternoon of **Wednesday 15th August 2018** will be notified.
